

Dear Camper and/or Parents,

We are looking forward to seeing you this summer at Joseph Badger Meadows. We will be having a great time together. Here is some information that will help you get ready and come to camp.

What to Bring

Have all medications with you at registration. They are to be turned in to the nurse. Do not pack them.

Mark these items with your name and pack them.

- Bedding: pillow, sleeping bag or sheets and blanket
- Flashlight with new batteries
- Toiletries: soap, toothbrush & paste, brush, comb, deodorant, etc.
- Towels & washcloths
- Clothing: shirts (some with long sleeve)
 - jeans and shorts
 - 2 pairs of shoes (avoid bringing flimsy sandals)
 - pajamas
 - rain gear
 - modest swimsuit & towel (no bikinis, if your only suit is a bikini, please bring a t-shirt to wear over your suit)
- Bible (We encourage campers to have their own Bible. If you do not have one or choose not to bring yours, Bibles will be available at JBM.)
- White T-shirt (Jr. Arts & Music & Art Expression campers ONLY)
- Insect repellent (stick or bottle is best)
- Water bottle especially for weeks with very hot weather

- Optional items: Dirty clothes bag
 Camera, book, stationery/stamps

DO NOT BRING: Cell phones, radios, cassette/CD players, TV, walkman, gameboy or other electronic games, jewelry, fireworks, cards, firearms, pets, food/gum/candy/other snacks, alcohol, tobacco or any other drug, money, pocket knives or any other weapon.

All personal items brought to camp by campers, staff or parents are the responsibility of the owner. JBM will attempt to locate items left behind, but cannot guarantee retrieval or replacement of lost personal belongings. Please notify us immediately of lost items.

Camp Arrival & Departure

Registration will be from 4:00-5:00pm on Sunday for each camp session. Please do not arrive early. The staff will be in a startup meeting and making last minute preparations before that time.

The Camp Nurse will be present to hear any medication concerns or special needs for your camper during the week. Please be sure you have returned your medical form to the camp office before camp registration. Have your medicines with you to turn in at this time.

The Camp Store will be open at this time with t-shirts, sweatshirts, hats, stamps, postcards, etc. You will need to order your camp picture at this time for pick up on the last day of each camp session.

The Campers are to go to their cabins following registration. They will meet their counselor and cabin friends. Campers are asked to remain with their counselor until the first group activity begins.

Each full week camp concludes on Friday evening after dinner (Kids Camp ends on Tuesday evening). Families are to pick up their campers at 6:00pm. We will do our best to keep the traffic moving upon pickup. Jr. Arts & Music Camp and Art Expression will conclude after the performance beginning at 5:45pm.
