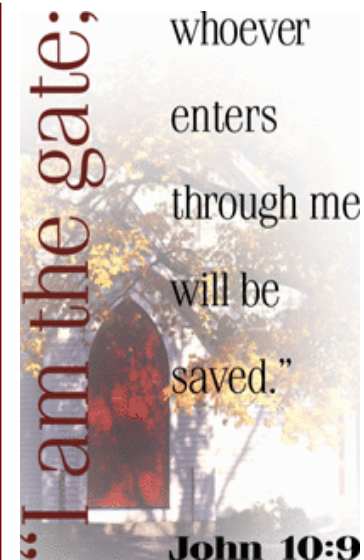

STEWARDSHIP RESOURCES

The Resource Center has nearly 100 books, videos, and CDROMs on stewardship in its collection. These resources explore the meaning of stewardship, help people understand the opportunities and results of stewardship, show congregations how to create a stewardship program, and explain special offerings in the PCUSA. Here is a sample of some of the resources available for your use:

1. Faithful and Wise

Ask most Christians what the word "stewardship" means to them and you will most likely get answers that center around giving money to the church. But in reality, money is just one of the gifts God has given us to use to His glory. "Faithful and Wise" is a 6 session study that looks at how we can expand our giving into every facet of our lives: possessions, time, talents and skills, physical environment, spiritual environment, and money. A study guide is included with the video.

2. The Stewardship of All Life

This five part study contains a study guide and a video. Each part of the video is 10 to 15 minutes long and discusses: Living with gratitude, stewardship of wealth, partnering with God in work, family and community, stewardship of power, and stewardship of the earth.

3. The Confident Steward

This interactive CD and Web-based year-round stewardship program:

- 1) Educates members about the biblical and theological meaning of stewardship.
- 2) Provides interpretation about how the church is being a faithful steward.
- 3) Asks the members of the church to commit themselves to the support of the church's stewardship program.
- 4) Guides you through suggested tasks each two months and provides information about each task.
- 5) Provides material to be used in the stewardship program.
- 6) Assists you in preparing your own materials.
- 7) Links you to interpretative information about the mission of the church.
- 8) Allows you to use professionally developed graphics on your own customized materials. Each CD contains a full program based on the type of stewardship commitment campaign you would like to use.
