Photocopy Rights and Restrictions

RIGHTS: Your purchase of photocopy rights for *The Parish Paper* INCLUDES ...

- Permission to photocopy or reprint for distribution to your organization's clergy, paid staff, governing boards, committees, and members/attendees of congregations *within your constituency* in any or all of the following ways: E-mail, U.S. Mail, reprinting in your newspaper/newsletter, and distribution at your meetings and training events. (This permission includes both faculty and students of subscribing seminaries.) Posting on your judicatory or institution's Website is permitted—providing that section of your Website is password protected and you only give the password to people within your constituency. Each congregation within your judicatory or organization's constituency—to which you distribute *The Parish Paper*—has permission to photocopy for local use as many copies as it needs.
- Permission to quote sentences and paragraphs (see the two restrictions below).
- If you mail photocopies with your newsletter or other mailings—using your U.S. Post Office Nonprofit Mailing Permit—most local Post Offices require that every item carry your organization's name and address.
 - *Option #1:* Above *The Parish Paper* masthead, type your organization's name, address, and "Photocopied by Permission."
 - *Option #2:* Cover *The Parish Paper's* entire masthead by pasting your organization's name, address, and your newsletter's name and logo, or the name for this section of your newsletter.
- Please do **not delete** our copyright notice on page 2!

RESTRICTIONS: Your purchase of photocopy rights does NOT include ...

- **NOT** the right to give to **ANY THIRD PARTY**—other than those listed above in the "**Rights**" section—**permission to photocopy or reprint** (in any quantity, no matter how small, whether for free distribution or for sale).
 - The term "ANY THIRD PARTY" includes any individual, congregation, or organization (clergy, church staff, layperson, regional denominational structure, seminary, secular organization, magazine, and book publisher).
 - *When someone other than the subscribing seminary, educational institution, or judicatory—or member of a congregation within that judicatory—photocopies or reprints any part of this intellectual property, he or she violates United States and International Copyright Laws. (The word "Copyright" is a legal term that means "the right to say who photocopies or reprints words, art, or music.")*
- **NOT** permission to **re-write** sentences, paraphrase sentences, or change the wording of sentences and paragraphs.
